

Dear Riders,

We are delighted to welcome you to the 30th FEST DER PFERDE 2026 at Immenhöfe!
To ensure that your stay is as enjoyable and well organized as possible, we kindly ask you to follow the instructions of our event staff at all times.
Below you will find all important information and contact details regarding the Fest der Pferde.

ARRIVAL

- For all riders stabling their horses, arrival is possible on Wednesday, 29 July 2026, from 07:00 to 16:00. During this time, our team will gladly assist you with unloading whenever possible.
- Horse transport vehicles must unload in the meadow below the showgrounds towards the golf course (see site map attached). Immediately after unloading, all transport vehicles must be moved to the designated parking area on the opposite side. Please follow the event signage and the instructions of the parking marshals.
- Riders competing only in the national classes who do not require a stable box (arrival from Wednesday, 17:30) should park in the designated trailer parking area (see attached map).
- After arriving, unloading your horses and parking your vehicle, please report to the Show Office as soon as possible. There you will receive your participant wristband. We would also like to take a photo of you for use exclusively during the event.
- Before each rider's start, every competitor will be introduced on the video screen with a photo, name and nationality (or riding club for national classes).
- By providing or approving your photograph, you consent to its display on the event video screen in accordance with applicable data protection regulations.
- From 17:00, everyone is invited to our Welcome Barbecue including the traditional beer keg tapping and 100 litres of complimentary beer.
- A reception for riders, helpers, and sponsors will take place on Thursday evening at 6:00 p.m. in the Frese family's garden, and everyone is cordially invited.

STABLE TENTS

- The stable tents will open on Wednesday, 29 July 2026, at 07:00.
- We will do our best to accommodate requests regarding stable boxes, neighbouring boxes and corner boxes; however, not every request can be guaranteed.
- Access is restricted to authorised persons wearing the appropriate wristbands (riders, grooms and owners).
- The initial bedding (wood shavings only) is provided.

- Straw, wood shavings and hay can be purchased from Stable Manager Martin Hembach daily from 09:00–10:00 and 14:00–15:00.
- No orders will be accepted outside these opening hours, including by telephone.
- Bedding and hay are distributed daily starting at 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited in the stable area, stable tents, and the fenced-in area, as well as in the indoor riding arena and the lunging arena. Riders are responsible for their grooms. A fee of €100 will be charged to the account of any rider—or whose groom—fails to comply with this rule.
- Stable manager Martin Hembach and his team ensure compliance with the established regulations. Please strictly follow their instructions.
- Please note: The stable area is designated exclusively for pedestrians and riders; vehicles of any kind are not permitted. For safety reasons, please park e-bikes and e-scooters outside the fenced area.

VETERINARY INSPECTION (VET CHECK)

- The VET Check will take place on Wednesday, 29 July 2026, from 11:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- The Re-Inspection will take place on Thursday, 30 July 2026, at 07:30 a.m.
- Please remember to record your horse's temperature in the FEI HorseApp starting three days before arrival.
- Riders stabling additional horses for the national competitions must present these horses and passports to the official veterinarian. These horses must also be registered in the FEI HorseApp with temperature records.
- Riders competing only in national classes will use the enclosed temperature form from three days before arrival.
- Please have your equine passport and a digital thermometer ready.

TRACES CERTIFICATE

The following information has been provided by the District Veterinary Office:

- Register for TRACES certificates by Friday, 31st July 2026, 10:00 a.m. with the Veterinary Office in Villingen-Schwenningen!
<https://www.lrasbk.de/index.php?La=1&ffmod=frm&object=frm,2961.86.1&FID=2961.86.1> Riders leaving Germany require a pre-export health certificate. Riders arriving from abroad must present a valid TRACES certificate.
- On Saturday, 1st of August 2026, at 10:00 a.m. an official veterinarian will issue pre-registered certificates. Fee: €40 cash.

DECLARATIONS

- Declaration deadline: 19:00 p.m. on the evening before the respective competition.
- Declarations must be submitted electronically via Equi-Score

MISCELLANEOUS

- Important: For safety reasons, the DPF regeneration function on all trucks must be switched off while on the showgrounds.
- The showers (including toilets) are located near the truck parking area and are open daily from 06:00a.m.–11:00a.m. and 04:00p.m.–11:00p.m..
- Wristbands and breakfast vouchers for grooms are available at the Show Office.
- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times throughout the venue.
- Lunging is only permitted in the indoor lunging arena and the adjacent paddock. Please follow the signage.
- As the truck parking area is approximately 400 metres from the stable tents, bringing a bicycle or scooter is recommended. Only electric motorised vehicles are permitted.
- If you wish to use a fan in the stable tents, only battery-operated fans are permitted.

CHILDCARE SERVICE

To allow our riding families to fully focus on their competitions, we offer professional childcare for children aged 3 years and older.

- Thursday & Friday: 02:00p.m. – approx. 05:00p.m.
- Saturday & Sunday: 09:00a.m. – approx. 12:00a.m.

The childcare takes place on a neighbouring farm and is provided by qualified educational staff. Children will be collected from the showgrounds at the beginning of the session and returned afterwards. Minimum participation: 4 children per day, Fee: €50 per child per day, Registration required by 27th of July 2026: +49 162 7353278
